Round House

It can be easily seen on the map, because this house has the shape of a ring. The house consists of 26 porches. Round house is a wonderful example of transformation of a typical Round House: 9-floor residential building.



The business-center "Avilon Plaza"

Modern office building, which catches the eye due to its unusual shapes. The "cube" has all sides glazed. There is a conference hall in the semicircular projection on the facade of the building.



"Kitezh"

The shopping and office center "Kitezh," which is often called "Titanic" by Muscovites, towers over the city near the Kiev railway station. The building is occupied by offices and residential units in which several activities: conferences, thematic seminars and trainings in Moscow.



House of Music

Moscow international House of music was opened in 2002 and became the first concert hall, built exclusively for classical music. Building looks very impressive during illumination in the evening.

House-Sail

According to the results of the Internet poll of the newspaper "Izvestia" the house was named "The House of 2007". This is probably one of the most famous buildings in Moscow, which gained numerous national titles — "House-Ear", "House-Drop", "Wave", "Mountain".



The Morozov Mansion

The merchant Arseny Morozov was impressed by the architecture of Spain and Portugal, and then decided to construct a building in the Moorish style in Moscow. In 1894 he donated money to build a house, which still remains one of the most impressive architectural structures of white stone.



House-Egg

"House-Egg" or "Egg of Faberge", is a residential house, built in 2002 In the Mashkov street close to Chisty Prudy boulevard and Pond.



Roman House

"Roman house" is believed to be one of the most beautiful modern buildings of Moscow. The newspaper "Izvestia" called it the most beautiful building of the capital over the last century. This is a residential building with 39 apartments, was commissioned in 2005.
